4. AUSTRALIAN FINANCIAL SERVICES LICENCE ("AFSL")

CBS is the holder of AFS Licence number 280372. This authorization authorizes us to provide the following financial services:

- Deal in OTC products, Warrants, Derivatives, Foreign Exchange, Equity contracts; and
- Provide General Advice in relation to these products to wholesale and retail clients.

The CBS Warrant is an over-the-counter option which allows clients to benefit from movements in the underlying market. Therefore clients must deal directly, and only, with CBS ie. open and close all positions with CBS.
